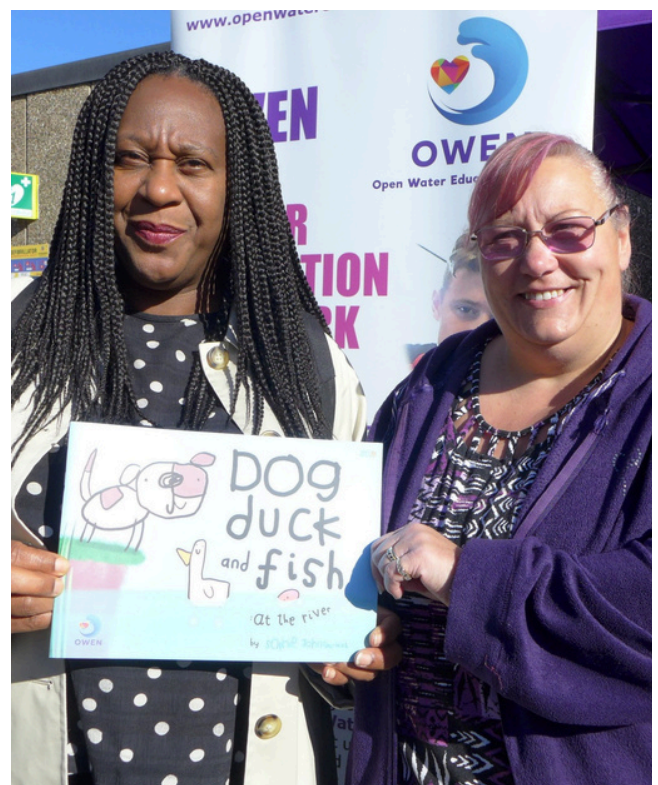
## STAPLEFORD & TROWELL BOUNDARY BROOK ACTION GROUP (SATBBAG)
