Dear Claire,

Hope you are well.

I am writing to you to submit the results of my Big Bus Survey on behalf of Broxtowe residents.

I am asking that the needs of Broxtowe residents are considered as part of your transport consultation as the East Midlands Combined County Authority prepares to develop its Transport Plan.

Broxtowe covers a wide geographical area, from Beeston to Brinsley, with towns including Stapleford and Eastwood, as well as rural villages Awsworth, Cossall and Trowell.

It is clear from residents' responses that their main concern is that existing bus services are infrequent with an insufficient number of stops which do not fulfil local demand. 67.1% of respondents stated that the available bus routes are insufficient in their area.

I join residents in calling for improved frequency of bus routes from Beeston Rylands, and new services from Stapleford and Trowell to fill the gaps left by the closure of the trentbarton 21 service.

I would be very grateful for the opportunity to meet with you in the near future to discuss further how your vision for the future of transport in the East Midlands can lead to the positive changes Broxtowe residents' need to see in their local bus services.
